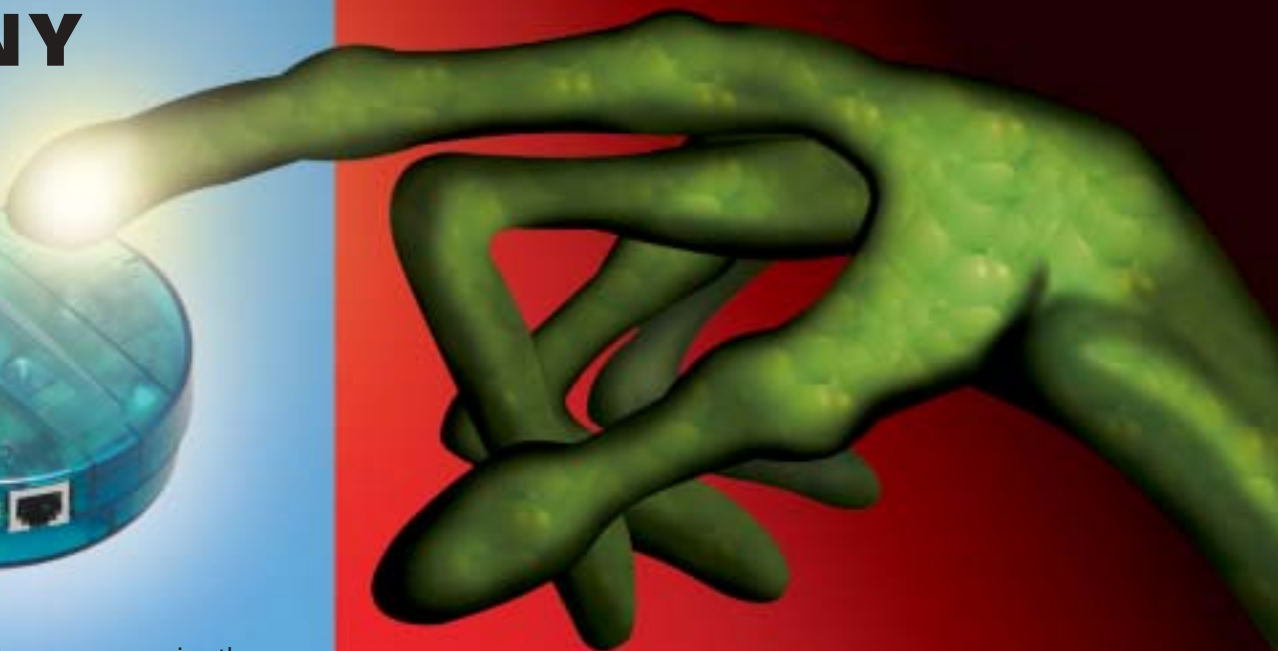
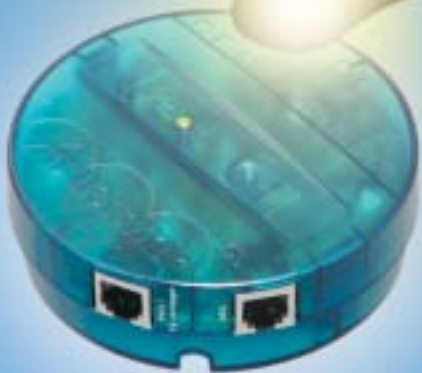

And why not save money when calling from your mobile? To call from a mobile phone via your Internet connection, simply enable the Call Through function on your Auerswald PBX system.

IP telephony for free – Auerswald makes it possible. Have a look at the details on the back of this brochure and see for yourself how simple it is!

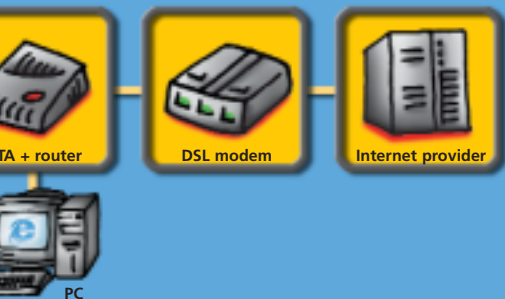
And here's yet another highlight:

* Applies if you already have a contract with a VoIP provider and when calling numbers within the same provider network or partner network.

** Requires a PBX system with analog extensions and a functioning ATA (analog telephone adapter) from your VoIP provider.

Example 1

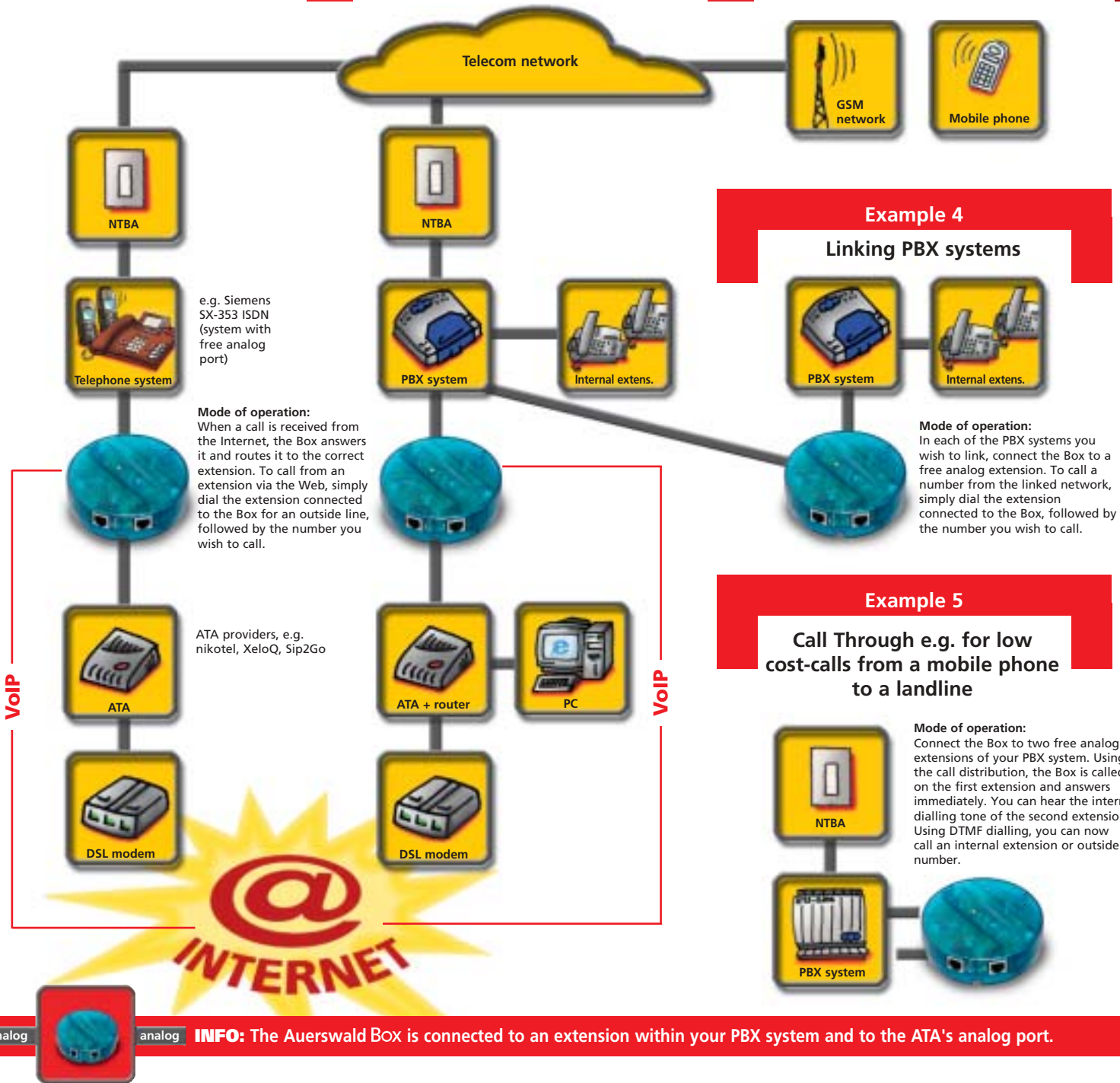
DECT IP telephony using an existing PBX system

e.g. Siemens SX-353 ISDN (system with free analog port)

Mode of operation:
When a call is received from the Internet, the Box answers it and routes it to the correct extension. To call from an extension via the Web, simply dial the extension connected to the Box for an outside line, followed by the number you wish to call.

ATA providers, e.g. nikelot, XeloQ, Sip2Go

Example 4

Linking PBX systems

Mode of operation:
In each of the PBX systems you wish to link, connect the Box to a free analog extension. To call a number from the linked network, simply dial the extension connected to the Box, followed by the number you wish to call.

Example 5

Call Through e.g. for low cost-calls from a mobile phone to a landline

Mode of operation:
Connect the Box to two free analog extensions of your PBX system. Using the call distribution, the Box is called on the first extension and answers immediately. You can hear the internal dialling tone of the second extension. Using DTMF dialling, you can now call an internal extension or outside number.

INFO: The Auerswald Box is connected to an extension within your PBX system and to the ATA's analog port.

To use free Internet telephony, a broadband Internet connection and a suitable rate are required (e.g. a DSL flat rate), which may incur additional costs. Only calls made to numbers within the same SIP network or a partner network are free of charge. Please contact your SIP provider for details.

With the Auerswald ISDN PBXs COMcompact 2204 USB, COMcompact 2206 USB, COMcompact 4410 USB, COMcompact 4406 DSL, COMmander Basic and COMmander Basic 19" a configuration of the Auerswald Box is not necessary, because the functions baby call / senior call of the system could be used to transfer an incoming Internet call directly to an internal subscriber or group.

The full range of functions described in this brochure may only be available if your entire phone system, and a linked PC if required, have been installed and configured by a professional. We recommend asking your specialist dealer for advice. For some functions, specific services will need to be activated by your network operator. The Auerswald Box is not intended for use on the public telephone network.
