Convert the K-1900-3 or C-4000 to a visitor entry system with hundreds of keyless entry codes

These controllers are normally used in apartment entry applications for calling tenant phone numbers. Special software can provide other applications. When a visitor picks up the phone (or presses "call"), they hear 6 seconds of dial tone. If they don't dial "#" plus a keyless entry code during the dial tone, the controller dials the operator or security personnel. Up to 256 keyless entry codes can be stored. The C-4000 is used in applications where there is up to 4 entry points or if PC programming of the keyless entry codes is desired (the K-1900-3 can only be touch tone programmed). Both controllers have a "LOG BUS" output, so entry activity can be logged to a printer or PC.

The C4K-DEA software can be field installed while the K193F-DEA software must be special ordered and factory installed.
