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# *Introduction*

Congratulations on your purchase of the Intelligent Xtension Recorder (XtR) Call Mynah Call Recorder!

The Call Mynah is part of an exciting range of cost-effective Digital call recorders from Intelligent Recording.

This quick reference guide will take you through the installation and setup of the Call Mynah software and help you begin recording your calls quickly.

## *PC Compatibility*

The Xtension Recorder desktop application software supplied will work on recent Microsoft operating systems including Windows XP, Vista, 7 systems. Note: Windows 95, 98, NT and Macintosh are not supported.

# *Product Registration*

It is very important you register your Call Mynah with us.

Registration provides you with free technical support for your Call Mynah hardware and software as well as free upgrades to the latest version of Call Mynah firmware and the Xtr Desktop software supplied with the Call Mynah.

## ***HOW TO REGISTER***

1. Visit [www.CallMynah.com/](http://www.CallMynah.com/) and click register.
2. Enter your details on the form provided.

Once registered, you will be ready to begin using the Call Mynah.

## *Software Installation*

Your Call Mynah comes complete with PC applications that allows you to manage your recordings on your PC.

You can install the software either by connecting your Call Mynah in USB mode and browsing for the Software directory, or by downloading it from <http://www.callmynah.com/>.

Run the **Setup\_CallMynah.exe** installer (you may need to unzip It first if downloaded from the website).

The installer installs two applications:

Xtr Call Mynah –View and change Settings and Phonebook entries, view, backup, and delete Calls.

Xtr Desktop – Play and manage calls on your PC.

## *XtR Call Mynah*

The XtR Call Mynah application allows you to modify the configuration of your Call Mynah easily from your PC. If your Call Mynah is connected when the application starts it will automatically detect the device and load the settings. If a Call Mynah is connected in USB mode while the application is running it will automatically load the settings from the device. Automatically loading settings will load all data from the device.

The settings are only ever saved back to the device when you click the Save button.


It is possible to load and save settings to or from another source. This allows you to backup settings, or use a common setup across a number of Call Mynah devices. When loading files manually only the page you load from is updated.

There are three main pages:

- Settings – General Device Settings
- Phonebook – Phonebook entries
- Call Log – Calls made and received

There is also an About page which contains information about obtaining support or downloading updated versions of the software.

## Settings Page

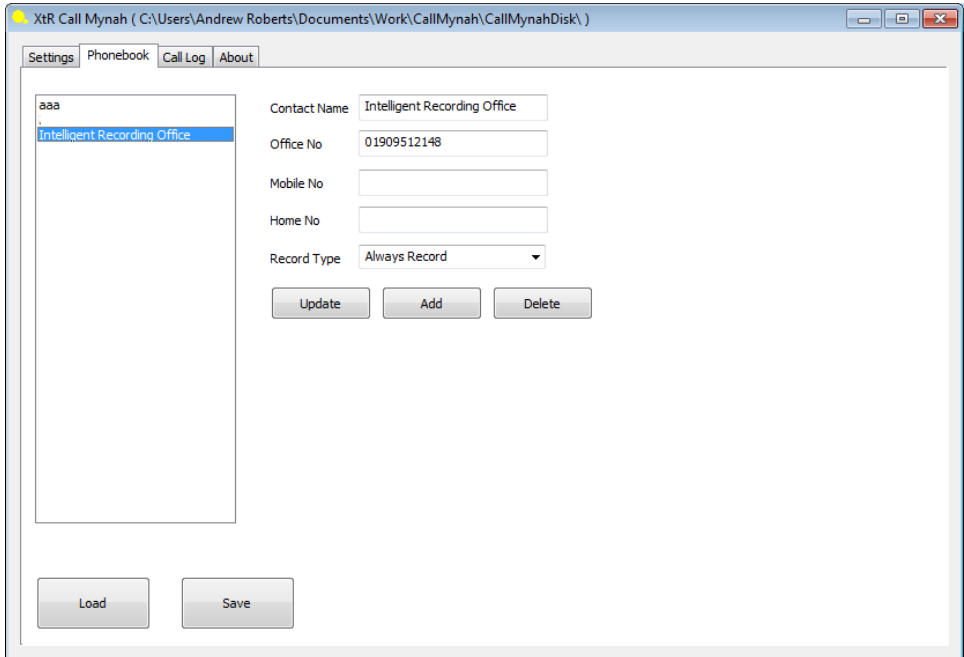
The title bar displays the location the settings are loaded from; this is usually automatically done for you. Only use the **Load** button if you want to load settings manually from a different location.

The settings are the same of those available from the Call Mynah menus. There is a limit of 10 predefined comments.

Clicking **Save** will allow you to save the settings back to the device. The default is to save to the same location the settings were loaded from.

Clicking **Default** will load some default settings.

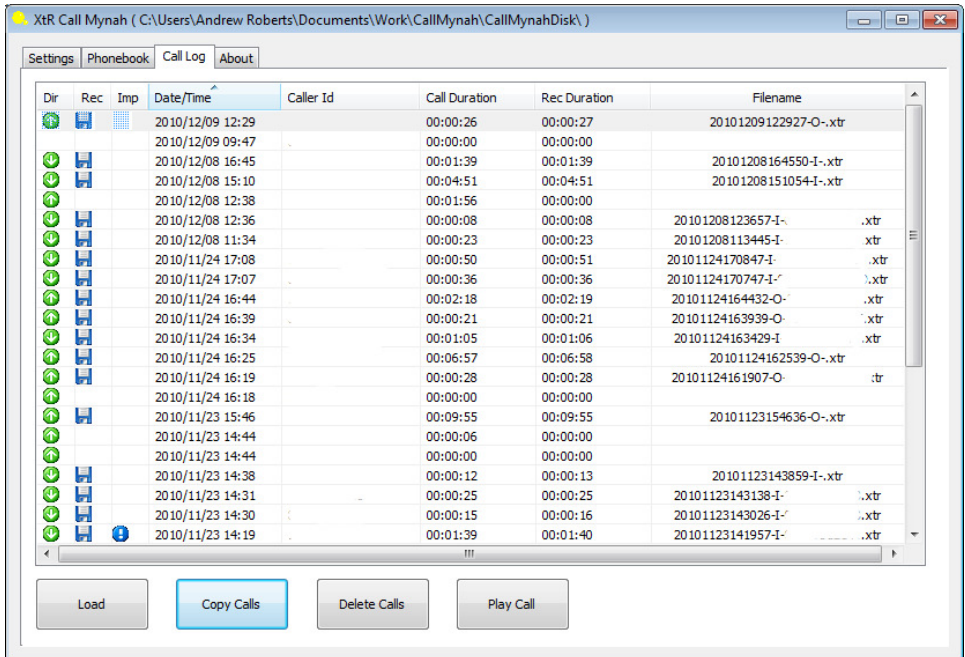
## Phonebook Page



The title bar displays the location the phonebook was loaded from; this is usually automatically done for you. Only use the **Load** button if you want to load a phonebook manually from a different location.

After changing the phonebook entries, remember to click **Save** to save the entries back to the device. You can optionally save the phonebook to your computer as a backup, or to transfer to another Call Mynah.

## Call Log Page



The title bar displays the location the call log was loaded from; this is usually automatically done for you. Only use the **Load** button if you want to load a call log manually from a different location.

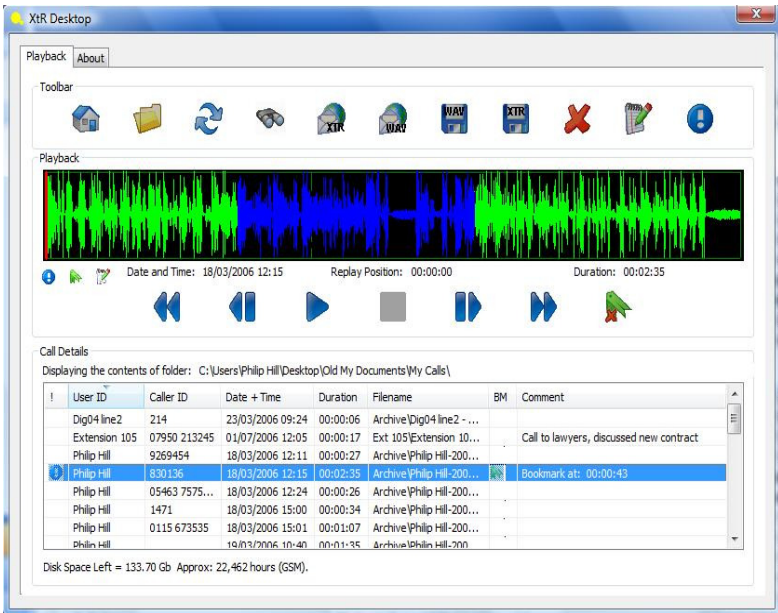
The **Copy Calls** button will copy the selected recordings to your PC. If no calls are selected then all calls are copied. By default this will be to a directory called “My Calls” in your home directory.

The **Delete Calls** button will delete the selected calls from the device. If no calls are selected then all calls are deleted. You will be prom

The **Play Call** button will play the first selected recording by launching the Xtr Desktop Player software.

# Xtr Desktop Software

Your Call Mynah comes complete with a PC application that allows you to manage your recordings on your PC.



The Xtr Desktop software is installed automatically along with the Xtr Call Mynah application, there is no need to install it separately.

The default recordings location is \My Documents\My Calls.

XtR Desktop allows you to list and search your recordings, listen to recordings, add comments, add a bookmark and email/export recordings. A summary of Toolbar features is given below.



Home – Lists calls at the specified home location

Folder – Changes the folder/drive where the your recordings are located (also allows you to change the home location)

Refresh – Refreshes the call list

Search – Set parameters and search through recordings

Email (Wav and XtR) – Emails highlighted call in wav or XtR format

Export (Wav or XtR) – Exports highlighted call in wav or XtR format

Delete – Deletes the highlighted call

Notepad (Annotate) – Add notes to the highlighted call (the Bookmark feature also adds specific information to the Notes field. Bookmark information should not be edited or you will lose the Bookmark)

Important – Adds important flag to highlighted call (stops auto delete)

### **Listing Calls Recorded Onto Your Call Mynah**

To list the calls on your Call Mynah, connect the Call Mynah to your computer and select the folder button. Point the recording location to your Call Mynah \RECORD folder. Alternatively you can transfer the

recordings to your PC hard drive first (using the Xtr Call Mynah application).

The list box allows you to list calls by User ID, Caller ID, Date and Time, Duration, Filename, Bookmarks and Comments. Simply click on the title header at the top of each column to list the calls in order.

To highlight a particular call for playback, email etc. (using the toolbar or playback buttons), simply click on the desired call.

Note – tool tips give extra information when your mouse is placed over the Filename and Comments fields.

You can edit the Caller ID field by ‘double clicking’ on the Caller ID entry.

The Calls details box shows the location of the current directory where calls are listed, the amount of disk space left and how many hours recording is left on the disk.

## *Playback Area*



The playback area allows you to manage the playback of the selected call in the call List.

Use the Play, Pause, Stop and Skip buttons to find the location you wish to playback. You can also click on the level indicator to choose a location (or double click to play).

The Bookmark button allows you to highlight a portion of the recording of importance. To enter a bookmark, click the start position of the important section and press the Bookmark key, then click the end location of the important section and click the bookmark key again.

Additional information in the Playback area includes:

- Date, Time and Duration of recording
- Current replay position
- If Important or if Notes (Annotation) or a Bookmark has been set
